



Converting a Content Folder into a Learning Module

The process of converting from a content folder into a **Learning Module** is straightforward, with just a few steps to accomplish the process.



In a pre-existing course that has the folders built already, the first step is to copy the title of the folder by selecting the 3 ellipses on the right side of the content module and choosing **Edit**.



The **Edit** window will open in a right-side pane and you will then copy the name given to the folder by highlighting the title and either right clicking and selecting **Copy** or choosing **Ctrl+C**.




Once copied, close the pane to continue.








You will then hover above the content folder module and a light purple line will appear with a + sign. Click the + sign and choose Create.




When **Create** has been selected, a panel on the right will open and you will then select **Learning Module** from the **Create Item** list.








Once the panel is replaced with the **Learning Module** pane, you will paste or **Ctrl+P** the title from the copied folder title, change the **Hidden from Students** to **Visible to Students**, add a description if needed, and add a picture to enhance the visual of the cascading **Learning Module**. You will have the option to adjust the image once selected. **Click Save.**



Once you have saved the changes, you will return to the course layout. You will now see the new **Learning Module** and image. The next step is to open the folder to view the contents that you want to move into the **Learning Module**. You will slowly drag the individual modules by clicking the vertical ellipses on the left side of the content module titles. As you drag toward the **Learning Module**, allow the module to open. A horizontal line will appear, and you can now place the content module inside the wrapper of the **Learning Module**. A light purple glow will highlight the position as you release the content module.







You can now drag the remaining content folder modules into the **Learning Module**. These steps will be repeated for each content folder needing to be converted. If you are building a course from scratch, the **Learning Modules** can be created all at once and the content copied in when available. Currently, you have a maximum of 2 folders of content depth allowed with the **Learning Module** being the first.
